Ceesay Ceesay and Others v. Spain

Dear Sir,

I write to inform you that on 4 October 2013 Mr Ceesay Ceesay and others (see list above) lodged the above application with the European Court of Human Rights under Article 34 of the European Convention on Human Rights.

In the proceedings before the Court the applicants are represented by Mr B. Salellas i Vilar, a lawyer practising in Girona.

On 15 October 2013 the Acting President of the Section to which the case has been allocated decided, in the interests of the parties and the proper conduct of the proceedings before the Court, to indicate to your Government, under Rule 39 of the Rules of Court, that the applicants should not be evicted until 29 October 2013.

The parties' attention is drawn to the fact that failure of a Contracting State to comply with a measure indicated under Rule 39 may entail a breach of Article 34 of the Convention. In this connection, reference is made to paragraphs 128 and 129 of the Grand Chamber judgment of 4 February 2005 in the case of *Mamatkulov and Askarov v. Turkey* (applications nos. 46827/99 and 46951/99) as well as point 5 of the operative part.

The Acting President also decided to request your Government, under Rule 54 § 2 (a) of the Rules of Court, to submit the following information:

Which are the measures that the domestic authorities intend to implement with regard to the applicants, particularly the children, in light of their vulnerability, in order to prevent the alleged violation of Article 3 and 8 of the Convention? In particular, which are the arrangements regarding housing and social care envisaged by the domestic authorities? The Government are requested to provide detailed information as well as the dates envisaged for implementation.
